Dr. David Luke's scholarship focuses primarily on understanding racial diversity in higher education. In his forthcoming book with Routledge Taylor & Francis Group, provisionally titled, "Affirmative Action and Black Student Success: Pursuing a 'Critical Mass' at Historically White Universities" he discusses the impact of diversity initiatives on black student enrollment and retention at three universities (two in the U.S. and one in Canada). Now as a practitioner, Dr. Luke leverages his insights to create and assess diversity programs in order to improve the retention and graduation rates of students of color and other marginalized groups.
